What is it all about?

Teaching Artist Dee Deegan is currently undertaking a Diploma in Creativity and Innovation in Education with University College Dublin. As part of her studies Dee is developing an action learning project aimed at empowering teachers to confidently integrate creativity across the curriculum. Dee is looking for primary schools in Galway city and county to take part in this exciting pilot CPD programme.

Schools are being asked to register their interest now to take part in the pilot workshops during the 2024/25 academic year.

- Schools will be asked to sign up for one or two 90-minute CPD workshops with Dee.
- Workshop 1 will take place during the Sept to Dec 2024 term.
- Workshop 2 will take place during the Jan to Easter 2025 term.
- The workshops will be held after school hours (schools may have the option to include them as part of their Croke Park hours).
- Workshops will generally be held on Mondays or Fridays.
- Participating schools must agree to participate in a evaluation process after each workshop.
- All workshops will take place in your school.
- There is no cost for the delivery of the workshops, however, schools may be asked to provide some basic art materials and photocopying.

Workshop Aims

- Provide training and resources to support teachers with innovative and practical ways to include creativity across the curriculum within their teaching and learning.
- Boost teacher confidence in using creativity in their classroom.
- Build teacher's capacity to make connections across subject areas.
- Inspire a change in teaching methodologies that offer students more choice and build critical thinking skills.
- Support teachers to be more flexible with the processes they use and feel more comfortable with uncertain outcomes.

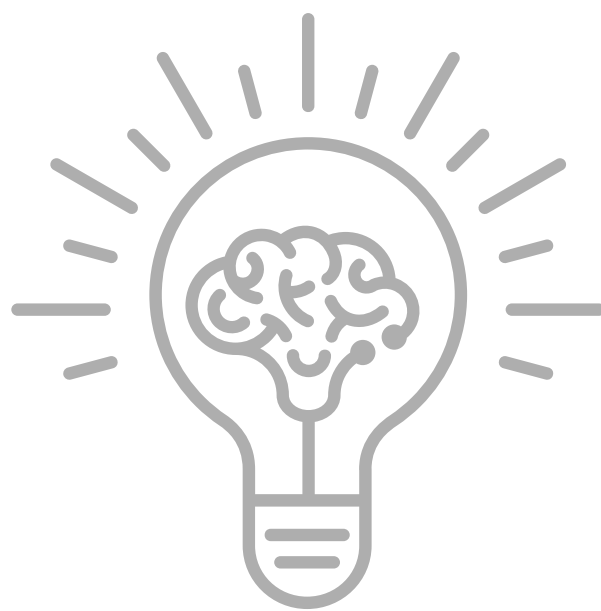
